The only way I have spiritual jurisdiction in assisting my people, and vice versa, is when they have fully completed the entire registration process. You may know people who attend Saint Cabrini, but may have not registered yet. Please mention this very important information to them. Text from the original message -

Hello, Everyone:

As we approach our first anniversary as a new community of faith in Lake Nona and in celebrating Eucharist at Saint Cabrini, it amazes me how far we've come – given the couple of major interruptions that were laid before us. From day one I asked everyone to stay "fluid," and to bear with us as we gather in our unique environment and plan for the road ahead. Thanks so much for all you have done – and continue to do – in supporting your Parish this first year.

Today I am writing to you with exciting news about the next milestone in our Parish Formation - the creation of our Finance and Building Committees. These three-person committees (each) will work with me and serve as the voice of the parish on critical matters as we move into our second year. Please note: It is preferred that the same person not be on both committees.

I know many of you are willing and ready to step up and help; it has been that way since we first began with our pop-up meetings in Lake Nona. Now we need to go a little deeper in surfacing some specific skill-sets and experience from our congregation that will take us to the next level. Below I will briefly outline the responsibilities of each committee, the qualifications, and how to apply.

Parish Building Committee Description: The Parish Building Committee will be charged with working closely with our Diocesan Ecclesiastical Properties Secretariat in the construction of our Parish Multi-Purpose Hall.

Parish Building Committee Qualifications:

- Registered (through REALM) & Practicing Catholic (in person or virtually) of Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini Catholic Church, in good standing.
- Extensive experience in construction, building, design, or architecture; previous Church building committee experience is a plus.
- Active & approved/cleared fingerprints on-file with the Diocese of Orlando; or commitment to provide approved/cleared fingerprints prior to the first parish meeting.
- Attendance at a handful of Diocesan Meetings, if necessary.

Parish Finance Committee Description: The Parish Finance Committee is a consultative body assisting the Pastor in the financial affairs of the Parish and in the development, execution and management of the Church's annual budget as regulated by universal laws and norms issued by the Diocesan Bishop.

- Registered (through REALM) & practicing Catholic (in person or virtually) of Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini Catholic Church, in good standing.
- Extensive experience in accounting and/or finance; previous Church Finance Committee experience is preferred.
- Active & approved/cleared fingerprints on-file with the Diocese of Orlando; or commitment to provide approved/cleared fingerprints prior to the first Parish meeting.
- Attendance at just a handful of Diocesan Meetings, if necessary.

Qualifications:

To Apply: If you are interested in applying for either of these committees, please complete the application attached to this email and return it and additional documents to info@saintcabrinicatholic.org by October 23 now October 30th, 2020. All applications will be reviewed by myself and the Diocese of Orlando. Eligible candidates will be contacted by November 1st, 2020 with information about Safe Environment & Fingerprinting.


