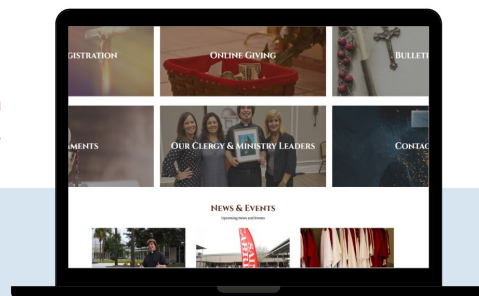

Also this weekend I am happy to announce the inaugural roll out of our own 'Mini' Faith Formation Program, beginning this Fall. It's a 'Mini' Program because we have to start small and grow it as time goes by. We have a Coordinator - who will be introduced shortly. In the meantime, this bulletin page will explain some basic Questions and Responses that you may have. **We start with an Invitation to those who have been Catechists (in other Parishes) and to those who may be interested in training to be a Catechist. The success of our Program depends on the number of volunteers who are available to assist us in this exciting new adventure in the growth of Saint Frances Xavier Catholic Church. Q: What is the first thing needed with this new program?

R: We need **CATECHISTS!**

Q: Why does a Parish offer a Faith Formation Program?

R: A Parish offers it to assist parents - who are the primary teachers of the Faith to their children at home.

Q: Who will be Coordinating this 'Mini' Program?

R: Introduction upcoming!

Q: What will the name of our new Program be - and why?

R: It will be called a 'Mini' Faith Formation Program because, at this point, we are not equipped to accommodate a large number of children. Our Program will target certain groups.

Q: When will the Program begin?

R: Sunday, September 5th, 2021.

**Be A Catechist!**

Q: How long does it run?

R: 9 AM to 10:15 AM

Q: What target groups will be attending our 'Mini' Faith Formation Program?

- R:
- \* 1st & 2nd Graders: Needing the Sacraments of First Reconciliation & First Holy Communion.
  - \* 7th & 8th Graders: Needing the Sacrament of Confirmation.
  - \* 9th thru 12th Graders: Youth Group.
  - \* R.C.I.C. (Rite of Christian Initiation of Children): Children over the age of 7 years old who need Baptism/Communion/Confirmation.
  - \* R.C.I.A. (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults): Adults (and High Schoolers) who need Baptism/Communion/Confirmation.

Q: What do I do if my child doesn't fall into any of the target groups?

R: We encourage parents to fulfill their mission in teaching them at home or keep them enrolled in current programs at other Parishes - until we are able to expand our Program in the future.

Q: How often will it meet - and where?

R: The 1st & 2nd Sundays of each month - (except if schools are on break). Meets in Media Center.

Q: Will there be a parent component?

R: Yes - we are looking to provide a creative opportunity for parents to gather while children are in class.

Q: If my child needs 1st Holy Communion or Confirmation - how long will they be preparing?

R: Both Sacraments are 2 year Programs.

Q: Is there a charge?

R: We will be asking for a suggested donation. TBD
