My Dear Sisters & Brothers in Christ,

Thanks to Dr. Joe and Guinevere for being at all of the Masses last weekend to introduce our upcoming 'Mini' Faith Formation Program - and Thanks to everyone who stepped forward to assist. It was a beautiful show of support. And a Happy 4th of July Independence Day Weekend to everyone! Be safe in your travels and celebrations!

This weekend's Gospel (Mark 6: 1-6) shares a very relevant and connective element to life as we know it - being in a 'state of disbelief.' Though somewhat common, it happens when we may not have seen or been in contact with (for a while) someone we are familiar with and then, if we are able to connect again, realize that things have changed - the person has grown and may not be what we remember of them for a variety of reasons.

The same happened with Jesus. When He went back home, the people who were familiar with Him were amazed and astonished at how different a man He turned out to be - and how He grew into a great teacher and prophet - proclaiming a message of moral reform, mercy, and salvation. This didn't sit well with them - to the point of their rejecting Him.

How does this relate to us? As Baptized Christians, we are all called to share in Jesus' mission - and when we take on the difficult task of proclaiming His message of moral reform, mercy, and salvation to family members or friends, we may be faced with controversy and ridicule - which may make us think twice. Let us realize that the wisdom of the Gospel is not our own, and is intended for us to share. May we show God that, by being grateful to what was revealed to us, we are willing to share it with others - even if they are challenged by hearing it.

On a personal note, I would appreciate you keeping my Dad, Vincenzo 'Jimmy', in your prayers. His health took a turn right before Father's Day and he is not doing well. We were able to celebrate his birthday this past Monday, but he continues to decline and is waiting for the Lord to come to take him home. Thanks very much!

Faith Formation Corner

My wife Guinevere and I wanted to thank the Saint Cabrini Parish for your kind welcome last weekend. The interest that was shown by parishioners was extraordinary!

Importantly, as we build our program, we will provide weekly updates of information in the E-Bulletin.

The below provides a basic outline of info for the current Phase I of our 'Mini' Faith Formation Program.

Saint Cabrini's 'Mini' Faith Formation Program will consist of five components:

Candidates making their Holy Sacraments:

- 1) 1st & 2nd Graders: Needing the Sacraments of First Reconciliation & First Holy Communion.
- 2) 7th & 8th Graders: Needing the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Other Programs Offered:

- 3) 9th thru 12th Graders: Youth Group.
- 4) R.C.I.C. (Rite of Christian Initiation of Children). For those over the age of 7 needing Sacraments.
- 5) R.C.I.A. (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). For high schoolers and older needing Sacraments.

Our 'Mini' Faith Formation Program will start on **Sunday, September 5th, 2021**. We will meet in the **School Media Center** on the **1st & 2nd Sundays** of each month from **9 AM to 10:15 AM** - (except if schools are on break).

We will communicate the student enrollment process shortly. Again, we ask for your prayers, patience, involvement, and support as we build and launch our inaugural 'Mini' Faith Formation Program at Saint Cabrini Catholic Church.

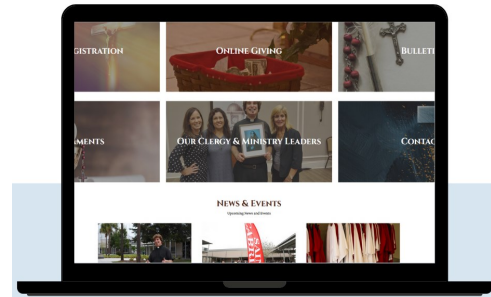

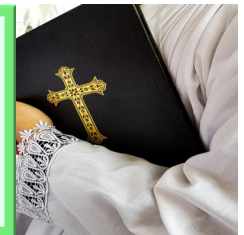

Safe Environment Certification Process For Volunteers Who Have Already Been Approved By Their Ministry Lead (See Page 2 For Your Ministry Options And Contact Info)

What is Safe Environment Training?

The Diocese of Orlando is required by the United States Catholic Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) to follow certain guidelines with regard to Safe Environment Training. As with all other archdioceses and dioceses, we are required to undergo regular audits by the USCCB to be sure that we are in compliance with those regulations.

All Church Personnel and volunteers working with children and vulnerable populations must complete Safe Environment Training in addition to a background/fingerprint clearance. In an effort to ensure the safety of those persons under the care of the Diocese, all Church Personnel and volunteers, ages 15 and older, will be required to submit a completed Criminal Background Check Form as well as a complete set of fingerprints so as to facilitate a criminal background investigation.

How to complete Safe Environment Training?

1. Watch Safe Environment Certification video. Your Ministry Lead will provide access information.
2. When video is complete, read the Diocesan Standards of Conduct & agree to terms. Proceed to Quiz.
3. Select either: **PARISH/school/diocesan entity**. Your Ministry Lead will provide the code.
4. Passing Scores are 80% and above.

You may immediately download your certificate. The results will also be emailed to selected Diocesan Entity and to the Human Resources Secretariat. A field print code specific to that entity will appear on screen. You need this code for next step.

Fr. Tuttle will be assisting at Corpus Christi Catholic Church for the month of July.
