

Importantly, registration will remain open to the first class start date of **September 12, 2021**. Now that registration is available, and we move closer to the start of classes on **September 12, 2021**, we thank our Parish Families and Parishioners for being part of Saint Cabrini's history!

REGISTRATION CONTINUES: The *Faith Formation* table will continue to be available at the end of this weekend Masses; Saturday: 5 PM; Sunday: 8:30 & 10:30 AM. The registration consists of:

- * Bring a copy of Sacramental Certificates your child(ren) may have. If you do not have the Certificate in your possession, please contact your child's Parish of Baptism to begin the process.
- * Bring the completed Registration Form. Form was emailed to interested families and is also available in person after Mass.
- * Bring Tuition & Sacramental Fees (Exact Cash/Check credit card not available).

Tuition: One Student: \$65.00 / Two Students: \$120.00 / Three or more students: \$170.00.

Sacramental Preparation Fee:

First Reconciliation/First Eucharist: \$50.00 per student. Confirmation (8th grade and up): \$50.00 per student.

Diaconate Discernment Nights

The Diocese of Orlando has 250 permanent deacons and another 51 in formation. Diaconate Formation is a comprehensive Ministry formation process involving the four pillars of: Human, Spiritual, Pastoral, and Intellectual Formation. This 6-year Formation process prepares the future ordained Permanent Deacon for his lifelong Vocation and Ministry of: Liturgy, Word, and Charity.

The Office of the Permanent Diaconate in the Diocese of Orlando is calling on its Church Communities to surface and bring forth reputable men - servants in the vineyard who are filled with the Holy Spirit - to discern a call to the Permanent Diaconate. Men seeking to discern this call are encouraged to first have an investigative inquiry and conversation with their pastor, followed by attending a Diaconate Discernment Night. Choose one of the six Discernment Sessions which will be held at Catholic Churches throughout the Diocese in September and October for the convenience of all.




Getting Started

At a minimum, your profile should include:

- 3. At least **one** online giving donation.
