

TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"Then Jesus left the vicinity of Tyre and went through Sidon, down to the Sea of Galilee and into the region of the Decapolis. There some people brought to him a man who was deaf and could hardly talk, and they begged Jesus to place his hand on him. 




Around the Parish

Deaconate Discernment Nights

The Diocese of Orlando has 250 permanent deacons and another 51 in formation. Diaconate Formation is a comprehensive Ministry formation process involving the four pillars of: Human, Spiritual, Pastoral, and Intellectual Formation. This 6-year Formation process prepares the future ordained Permanent Deacon for his lifelong Vocation and Ministry of: Liturgy, Word, and Charity.

The Office of the Permanent Diaconate in the Diocese of Orlando is calling on its Church Communities to surface and bring forth reputable men - servants in the vineyard who are filled with the Holy Spirit - to discern a call to the Permanent Diaconate. Men seeking to discern this call are encouraged to first have an investigative inquiry and conversation with their pastor, followed by attending a Diaconate Discernment Night. Choose one of the six Discernment Sessions which will be held at Catholic Churches throughout the Diocese in September and October for the convenience of all.

Faith Formation

THE 'Mini' FAITH FORMATION CORNER 09.05.2021



As our 'Mini' Faith Formation Program at Saint Cabrini gets closer to the September 12th start date, we want to take this opportunity to communicate and distribute to all participants the expected COVID protocols for program opening, which was requested of us from our Orlando Diocese.

While the COVID-19 positivity rate in your county is 8% or higher, masks will be required for all indoor activities – including children's catechesis, youth ministry, and adult ministry.

When the transmission status in your county is reduced below the 8% positivity rate, masks will become optional.

Due to the above 8% positivity rate in our area, Saint Cabrini's 'Mini' Faith Formation Program will require all students and adults to wear masks while inside the Media Center.

Vaccinated

People who are fully vaccinated can return to Parish activities after contact with someone who had COVID-19 **unless they have symptoms**. However, fully vaccinated people should get tested 3-5 days after their exposure, even if they do not have symptoms, and continue to wear a mask indoors following exposure.

Non-Vaccinated

Non-vaccinated individuals may not return to Parish activities for 14 days following exposure or show proof of a positive COVID-19 illness within the past three months and have no symptoms (cough, shortness of breath).

Anyone experiencing symptoms (Fever/Chills, Cough, Shortness of Breath, Fatigue, Muscle Aches, Headache, Loss of Taste, Sore Throat, Congestion or Runny Nose, Nausea, & Diarrhea) associated with COVID-19 must refrain from attending and participating in catechetical classes or events. We will be sensitive regarding attendance and health due to the current COVID-19 pandemic.

All 2021-2022 Saint Cabrini 'Mini' Faith Formation guardians/parents of students and adult catechists will be required to sign a COVID-19 waiver.

The Orlando Diocese has implemented these COVID-19 protocols for the safety of our children, young people, and adults – and the situation will be monitored and adjusted as needed and communicated accordingly. HEALTH UPDATE

If you see on the news that our School had a health outbreak - or if you arrive for Mass and find the main gates at the street are closed, chances are that the Campus is on lockdown for sanitation and that Weekend Masses have been cancelled. If this happens, we will notify you via REALM/Social Media Venues.

Hurricane Reminder

If we are ever advised to remain home (around a weekend) in case of a hurricane threat, Masses will be cancelled. Notification will be sent out via REALM and posted on the Parish Website/ Facebook Pages.


