THIRTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

One of the scribes came up to Jesus, and asked him, "Which is the first of all the commandments?" Jesus replied, "This is the first: 'Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God is Lord alone! Therefore, you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the second, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' 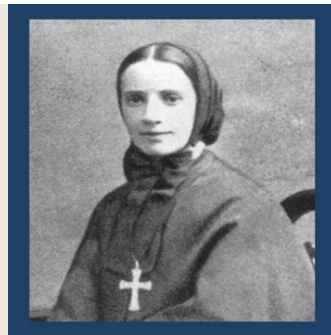

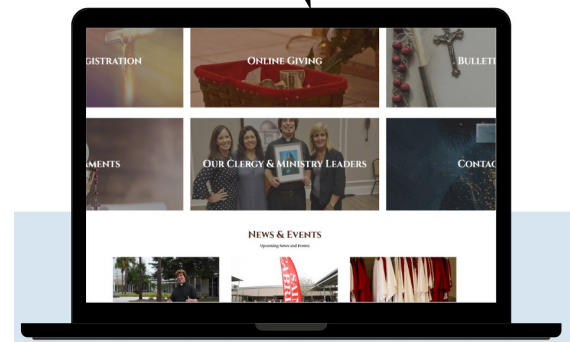

BOOK SIGNING

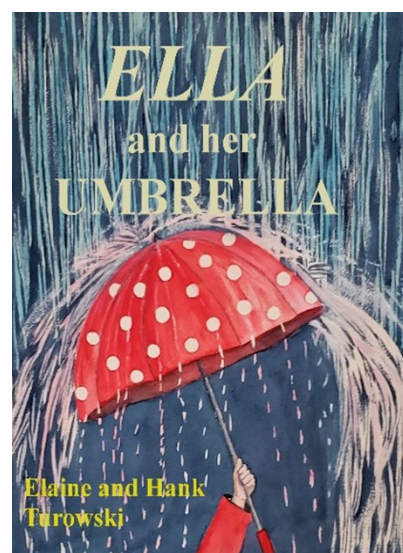
Parishioners Elaine and Hank Turowski
