My Dear Sisters & Brothers in Christ,

This weekend we conclude the 2021/2022 Christmas Season and prepare to go back to Ordinary Time as we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (Luke 3: 15-16, 21-22); where Jesus transitions into His public ministry and reminds us of the necessity of being Baptized.

Our basic catechesis informs us that (1) Baptism cleanses us of original sin; (2) Jesus was without sin; (3) Therefore He was not in need of Baptism; (4) Yet He chose to be Baptized and instructed John to do so; (5) Because that is the way to enter into a new life with Him.

In addition, we can also see a carry-over from the 'epiphany' or 'revelation' theme from last weekend because of what happened after Jesus emerged from the water: "Then a voice came down from the heavens: 'You are my beloved Son. On you my favor rests.'" (Lk 3: 21-22)

If we were to be a little creative with the word itself, we could say that Baptism implies the following:

- Bath of rebirth.
- Anointing with the Holy Spirit.
- Perfection as Christ lives in us.
- Total dedication to live the truth.
- Interior repentance.
- Seal of salvation.
- Mission to bear good fruits.

As we celebrate this Feast of the Baptism of the Lord we are reminded of the necessity of Baptism in relation to our salvation and to the mission entrusted to us when we were baptized in the Lord. Let's reevaluate that mission today, to see how we are fulfilling what it involves, and to see if we are doing it.
