FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

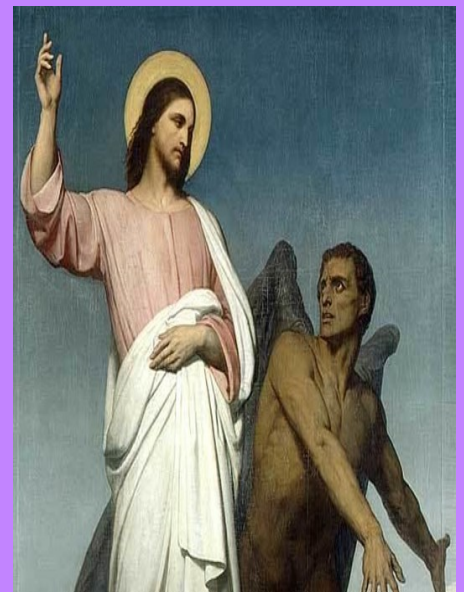

Lenten Guidelines

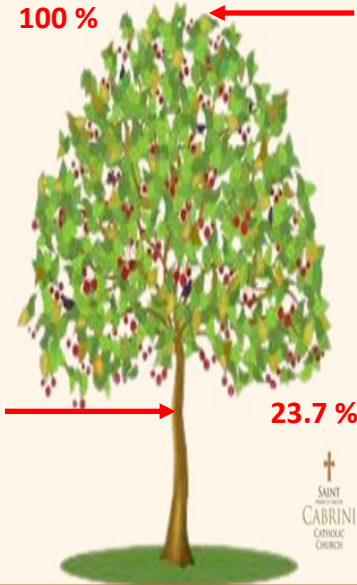
♦ **ON ASH WEDNESDAY, GOOD FRIDAY, AND ALL FRIDAYS OF LENT: EVERYONE OF AGE 14 AND UP ABSTAIN FROM EATING MEAT.**

♦ **ON ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY: EVERYONE OF AGE 18 TO 59 MUST FAST, UNLESS EXEMPT DUE TO A MEDICAL REASON. WHEN FASTING, A PERSON IS PERMITTED TO EAT ONE FULL MEAL THAT DAY, AND HAVE TWO SMALLER MEALS THAT TOGETHER ARE NOT EQUAL TO A FULL MEAL.**

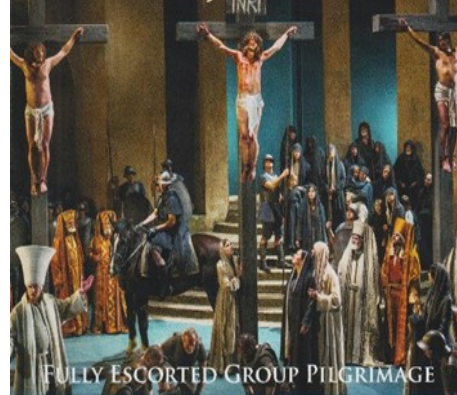
