Lenten Guidelines

- On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent: Everyone of age 14 and up abstain from eating meat.
- On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday: Everyone of age 18 to 59 must fast, unless exempt due to a medical reason. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal that day, and have two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Around the Parish

Question: At the end of the 11 month parishioner pledge system, when the O.C.A. Goal of a Parish has been paid - and a Parish goes over their O.C.A. Appeal Goal what happens to any over-goal dollars (overage)?

Answer: There is a 'share formula' in place that disperses any overage that may be accrued at the end of the O.C.A. Appeal time period - after the Parish goal is attained and paid off;

1/3 of overage will be given to a Parish need that they would like to address. (For Saint Cabrini, it would be to help supplement the school costs associated with our growing 'Mini' Faith Formation Program).

1/3 of the overage will be put into an Endowment Fund for Saint Cabrini Parish (held by The Catholic Foundation of Central Florida) for the exclusive long-term use of our Parish.

1/3 will be contributed to an Endowment Fund (held by the Catholic Foundation of Central Florida) to support retired priests in our Diocese.


