Now there were some present at that time who told Jesus about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mixed with their sacrifices. Jesus answered, "Do you think that these Galileans were worse sinners than all the other Galileans because they suffered this way? I tell you, no! But unless you repent, you too will all perish. My Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,



I also wanted to give our people an update of the 2022 Our Catholic Appeal (O.C.A.). The amazement of how conscientious this Community of Faith is, continues to be impressive. The report shows that Saint Cabrini parishioners have **pledged** over \$70,000.00 (and it's still rising!) with almost 150 families participating, so far. We all still need to do our part as a Parish, because we know that some of the pledges may not reach fruition. And, as mentioned in last week's Electronic Bulletin (and again, below), we as a Parish are going to benefit with any overage that is accumulated at the end of this journey. I am very excited that we will hopefully be able to supplement our 'Mini' Faith Formation Program with the renting of all the rooms we use for our children, young people, and adults needing Sacraments - and that we will hopefully be able to begin a Parish Endowment for the future (which we don't currently have) – as well as assist in the caring needs for our retired clergy. Question: At the end of the 11 month parishioner pledge system, when the O.C.A. Goal of a Parish has been paid - and a Parish goes over their O.C.A. Appeal Goal - what happens to any over-goal dollars (overage)?

Answer: There is a 'share formula' in place that disperses any overage that may be accrued at the end of the O.C.A. Appeal time period - after the Parish goal is attained and paid off;

1/3 of overage will be given to a Parish need that they would like to address. (For Saint Cabrini, it would be to help supplement the school costs associated with our growing 'Mini' Faith Formation Program).

1/3 of the overage will be put into an Endowment Fund for Saint Cabrini Parish (held by The Catholic Foundation of Central Florida) for the exclusive long-term use of our Parish.

1/3 will be contributed to an Endowment Fund (held by the Catholic Foundation of Central Florida) to support retired priests in our Diocese.

Lenten Guidelines

- · On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent: Everyone of age 14 and up abstain from eating meat.
- · On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday: Everyone of age 18 to 59 must fast, unless exempt due to a medical reason. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal that day, and have two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.
