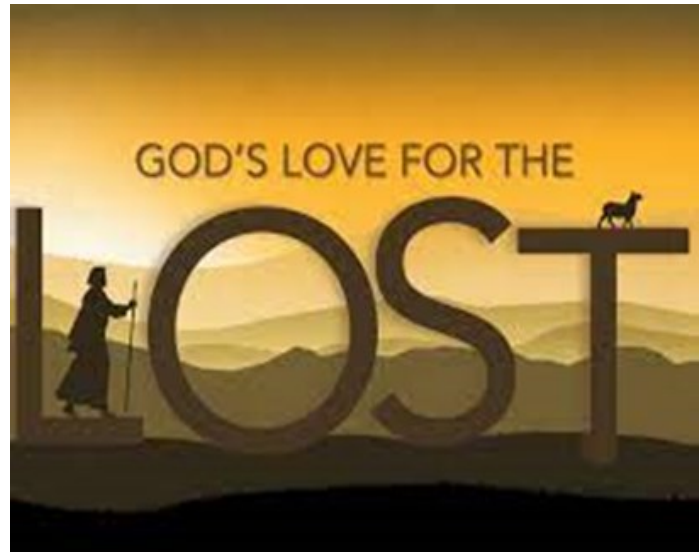

"Seeking the Lost"

Now the tax collectors and sinners were all gathering around to hear Jesus. But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them." Then Jesus told them this parable: "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.' I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent. "Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins and loses one. Doesn't she light a lamp, sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it? And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin.' 

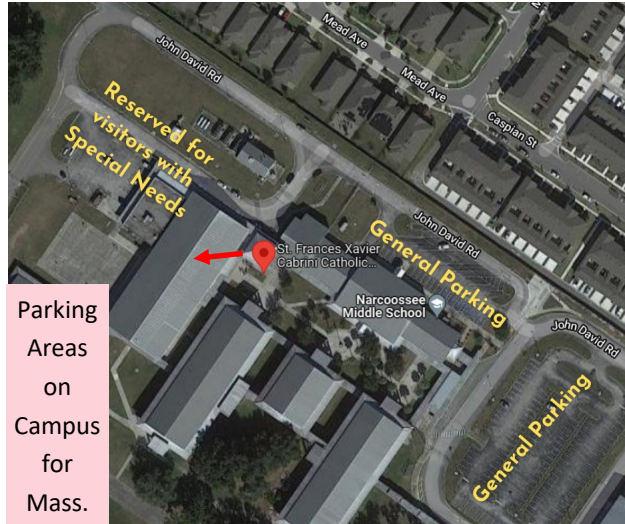

Ordained to the Priesthood: June 8, 1963

Please pray for the repose of the soul of Father Donald Mainardi. Father Mainardi arrived in the Diocese of Orlando in 1982 to serve as the director of San Pedro Spiritual Development Center from 1982-1983. After serving outside the diocese, he returned in 1991 as Parochial Vicar of St. Charles Catholic Parish in Orlando from 1991-1993; Administrator of St. Matthew Catholic Parish in Winter Haven in 1993; then Pastor of St. Charles Catholic Parish in Orlando from 1993-2000. He was incardinated into the diocese in 1993. Father Mainardi then served as Pastor of St. John the Baptist Parish in Dunnellon from 2000-2001 followed by Blessed Sacrament Parish in Cocoa from 2001-2003, when he retired. He served on several boards and councils, and after retiring he assisted at St. John the Evangelist Parish in Viera. "It has been a privilege to serve in the fullness of the priesthood," Father Mainardi has said. He was known as a gentle man and a fine preacher to the people of God.
