

Now the tax collectors and sinners were all gathering around to hear Jesus. But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them." 



Please pray for the repose of the soul of Father Donald Mainardi. Father Mainardi arrived in the Diocese of Orlando in 1982 to serve as the director of San Pedro Spiritual Development Center from 1982-1983. After serving outside the diocese, he returned in 1991 as Parochial Vicar of St. Charles Catholic Parish in Orlando from 1991-1993; Administrator of St. Matthew Catholic Parish in Winter Haven in 1993; then Pastor of St. Charles Catholic Parish in Orlando from 1993-2000. He was incardinated into the diocese in 1993. Father Mainardi then served as Pastor of St. John the Baptist Parish in

Dunnellon from 2000-2001 followed by Blessed Sacrament Parish in Cocoa from 2001-2003, when he retired. He served on several boards and councils, and after retiring he assisted at St. John the Evangelist Parish in Viera. "It has been a privilege to serve in the fullness of the priesthood," Father Mainardi has said. He was known as a gentle man and a fine preacher to the people of God.
