

Jesus said to the Pharisees: "There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and feasted splendidly every day. At his gate lay a beggar named Lazarus, who was covered with sores. Lazarus longed to eat the scraps that fell from the rich man's table. Even the dogs came and licked his sores." The time came when the beggar died and the angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried. From the abode of the dead, where he was in torment, he looked up and saw Abraham far away, with Lazarus by his side. 
