TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



Jesus said to the Pharisees: "There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and feasted splendidly every day. At his gate lay a beggar named Lazarus, who was covered with sores. Lazarus longed to eat the scraps that fell from the rich man's table. Even the dogs came and licked his sores." The time came when the beggar died and the angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried. From the abode of the dead, where he was in torment, he looked up and saw Abraham far away, with Lazarus by his side. So, he called to him, "Father Abraham, have pity on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, because I am in agony in this fire." But Abraham replied, "My child, remember that in your lifetime you were well off, while Lazarus was in misery. Now he has found consolation here, but you have found torment. And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been set in place, so that those who want to go from here to you cannot, nor can anyone cross over from there to us." He answered, "Then I beg you, father, send Lazarus to my family, for I have five brothers. Let him warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment." Abraham replied, "They have Moses and the Prophets; let them listen to them." "No, father Abraham," he said, "but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent."
