# FLCAN E-Update

The Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops is the nonpartisan public policy voice of the Catholic Bishops of Florida.

In keeping with its mission, the Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops (FCCB) seeks to educate Catholics and provide resources to assist the faithful with their responsibility to participate in political life. To help inform voters, FCCB has developed a comparison between the positions of the two major party candidates for Florida governor on a range of issues. The information has been compiled directly from policies, public statements, official or campaign websites, and other sources, as of September 13, 2022, for informational purposes only and does not serve as an endorsement of either candidate. This document is but one tool to help Catholics prepare for the election and is not a substitute for individual research and study. The issues that appear do not represent a complete list of issues that may be of importance to Catholics. The responsibility to make political choices rests with each individual in light of a properly formed conscience in accordance with human reason and the truths of our faith. The FCCB does not support or oppose candidates. Before voting, Catholics are called to consider a wide range of issues, weighing each according to its moral significance. Gaining familiarity with the candidates' positions on issues involving human life and dignity is essential to responsible, faithful citizenship. It is beneficial to research the ballot ahead of time and gather the facts for every proposal and race. The FCCB Voter Guide provides information about Catholic teaching, offers considerations on key topics, and poses questions regarding current issues to assist voters in evaluating candidate positions or political party platforms. **Sunday November 6<sup>th</sup> at 9 AM – Sacramental Preparation & R.C.I.A./R.C.I.C. Classes Continue**

If you have a child enrolled in Sacramental preparation or R.C.I.A./R.C.I.C., classes resume on Sunday, November 6<sup>th</sup> at 9 AM. Please look for your child's Catechists' name, they will be holding up signs with their names so that your child(ren) can easily find them and line up behind them. For dismissal, all students will be dismissed by class.

**New Student Registrations:** If you have not registered your children for Sacramental Preparation, we ask that you email Margarita Casas at: [Office@SaintCabriniCatholic.org](mailto:Office@SaintCabriniCatholic.org). We have room for more students in the 'Family' Faith Formation Program but **NOT** for the Sacramental Preparation classes. These classes are full, and we have run out of space.

**The following are options for you and your child(ren):**

**Students in 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> grade that have made their First Holy Communion:**

Enroll in the 'Family' Faith Formation Program that meets once a month.

**Students in 2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> grade that have not made their First Holy Communion:**

Enroll in the 'Family' Faith Formation Program. These students will automatically be enrolled in the Sacramental Preparation Classes for 2023/2024.

**Students in 7<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade that need First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation:** Enroll in Pflaum's Online (digital) Curriculum with the guidance of a parent. These students will automatically be enrolled in Sacramental Preparation Classes for 2023/2024.

There will always be exceptions and we want to be able to accommodate everyone's needs. Please be assured that we will find the best plan for you and your child(ren).

We thank you for your patience and understanding with our enrollment. Just to give you an idea, we have doubled in size this year and we want to continue to grow, but we also want to offer a quality, **Faith Filled** program for each student. Catechesis is very important for spiritual growth - and in understanding our **Catholic Faith** - and should be a loving and wonderful experience. This is what every student will receive here at Saint Cabrini, in our 'Mini' Faith Formation Program.
