Resurrection

Luke 20:27-38

Some of the Sadducees, who say there is no resurrection, came to Jesus with a question. "Teacher," they said, "Moses wrote for us that if a man's brother dies and leaves a wife but no children, the man must marry the widow and raise up offspring for his brother.

Now there were seven brothers. The first one married a woman and died childless. The second and then the third married her, and in the same way the seven died, leaving no children. Finally, the woman died too. Now then, at the resurrection whose wife will she be, since the seven were married to her?" Jesus replied, "The people of this age marry and are given in marriage. But those who are considered worthy of taking part in the age to come and in the resurrection from the dead will neither marry nor be given in marriage, and they can no longer die; for they are like the angels. They are God's children, since they are children of the resurrection. But in the account of the burning bush, even Moses showed that the dead rise, for he calls the Lord 'the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.' He is not the God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive."

The FCCB does not support or oppose candidates. Before voting, Catholics are called to consider a wide range of issues, weighing each according to its moral significance. Gaining familiarity with the candidates' positions on issues involving human life and dignity is essential to responsible, faithful citizenship. It is beneficial to research the ballot ahead of time and gather the facts for every proposal and race. The FCCB Voter Guide provides information about Catholic teaching, offers considerations on key topics, and poses questions regarding current issues to assist voters in evaluating candidate positions or political party platforms.

Sunday November 6th at 9 AM – Sacramental Preparation & R.C.I.A./R.C.I.C. Classes Continue

If you have a child enrolled in Sacramental preparation or R.C.I.A./R.C.I.C., classes resume on Sunday, November 6th at 9 AM. Please look for your child's Catechists' name, they will be holding up signs with their names so that your child(ren) can easily find them and line up behind them. For dismissal, all students will be dismissed by class.

New Student Registrations: If you have not registered your children for Sacramental Preparation, we ask that you email Margarita Casas at: Office@SaintCabriniCatholic.org. We have room for more students in the 'Family' Faith Formation Program but **NOT** for the Sacramental Preparation classes. These classes are full, and we have run out of space.

The following are options for you and your child(ren):

Students in 3rd to 6th grade that have made their First Holy Communion:

Enroll in the 'Family' Faith Formation Program that meets once a month.

Students in 2nd to 6th grade that have not made their First Holy Communion:

Enroll in the 'Family' Faith Formation Program. These students will automatically be enrolled in the Sacramental Preparation Classes for 2023/2024.

Students in 7th to 12th grade that need First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation: Enroll in Pflaum's Online (digital) Curriculum with the guidance of a parent. These students will automatically be enrolled in Sacramental Preparation Classes for 2023/2024.

There will always be exceptions and we want to be able to accommodate everyone's needs. Please be assured that we will find the best plan for you and your child(ren).

We thank you for your patience and understanding with our enrollment. Just to give you an idea, we have doubled in size this year and we want to continue to grow, but we also want to offer a quality, *Faith Filled* program for each student. Catechesis is very important for spiritual growth - and in understanding our *Catholic Faith* - and should be a loving and wonderful experience. This is what every student will receive here at Saint Cabrini, in our 'Mini' Faith Formation Program.
