

Jesus said: "You have heard that it was said, 'Eye for eye, and tooth for tooth.' But I tell you, do not resist an evil person. If anyone slaps you on the right cheek, turn to them the other cheek also. And if anyone wants to take your shirt, hand over your coat as well. If anyone forces you to go one mile, go with them two miles. Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you." # Lenten Guidelines

- On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent: Everyone age 14 and up abstain from eating meat.
- On Ash Wednesday & Good Friday: Everyone age 18 to 59 are encouraged to fast, unless exempt due to a medical reason. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal that day, and have two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.
