The National Eucharistic Revival restores Eucharistic understanding and devotion to this great mystery here in the United States by helping us renew our worship of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. As the Church has withstood may trials and tribulations throughout our very human history, the acknowledgement that Jesus is present in the midst of roaring waves reminds us that He is more powerful than the storm. He desires to heal, renew, and unify the Church and the world by uniting us once again around the source and

summit of our faith - The Celebration of the Eucharist! This joyful, expectant, and grassroots response of the entire Catholic Church in the U.S. calls us to re-commit ourselves to Jesus' divine invitation by enkindling, again, a living relationship with the Lord in the Holy Eucharist. How is this Revival outlined?

June, 2022 - June, 2023: The Year of Diocesan Revival begins! June, 2023 - June, 2024: This second year fosters Eucharistic Devotion at the Parish level, strengthening our liturgical life through adoration, missions, resources, preaching, and organic movements of the Holy Spirit. These local efforts will help convert hearts and minds to fall more deeply in love with Jesus Christ, truly present in the Holy Eucharist. In the Diocese of Orlando, we are having a Eucharistic Pilgrimage on June 10th, 2023.

July, 2024: The National Eucharistic Congress! At this historic event, more than 80,000 Catholics of all ages will gather in Indianapolis to worship our Risen Lord in His humble disguise. The Holy Spirit will enkindle a missionary fire in the heart of our nation as we re-consecrate ourselves to the source and summit of our faith.

July, 2024 - July, 2025: The National Year of Mission! From the Congress in 2024 through Pentecost of 2025, the entire American Church will be sent on mission to share the gift of our Eucharistic Lord with their local communities and beyond. Let the light shine forth!

2025: The Vatican has announced that 2025 will be a Jubilee Year with the motto 'Pilgrims of Hope.' Pope Francis believes the 2025 Jubilee will "contribute greatly to restoring a climate of hope and trust."


