Jesus told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field. But while everyone was sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and went away. When the wheat sprouted and formed heads, then the weeds also appeared. The owner's servants came to him and said, 'Sir, didn't you sow good seed in your field? Where then did the weeds come from?' 'An enemy did this,' he replied. The servants asked him, 'Do you want us to go and pull them up?' 'No,' he answered, 'because while you are pulling the weeds, you may uproot the wheat with them. Let both grow together until the harvest. At that time, I will tell the harvesters: First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles to be burned; then gather the wheat and bring it into my barn."



In January of 2021, Pope Francis instituted a Church-wide celebration of a 'World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly' to be held every year on the fourth Sunday of July, beginning on July 25, 2021, near the liturgical memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus. Pope Francis said, "the Holy Spirit even today stirs up thoughts and words of wisdom in the elderly." The voice of the elderly "is precious," he said, "because it sings the praises of God and preserves the roots of the people." The elderly, he continued, "remind us that old age is a gift and that grandparents are the link between the different generations, to pass on to the young the experience of life." "The elderly must not be forgotten," The Holy Father said as he instituted the 'World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly' because "grandparents are often forgotten, and we forget this wealth of preserving roots and passing on" what the elderly have received. 
