



Jesus told his disciples this parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out early in the morning to hire workers for his vineyard. After reaching an agreement with them for the usual daily wage, he sent them into his vineyard. About nine in the morning he went out and saw others standing in the marketplace doing nothing. He told them, 'You also go and work in my vineyard, and I will pay you whatever is fair.' So, they went. He went out again about noon and about three in the afternoon and did the same thing. About five in the afternoon he went out and found still others standing around. He asked them, 'Why have you been standing here all day long doing nothing?' 'Because no one has hired us,' they answered. He said to them, 'You also go and work in my vineyard.' When evening came, the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Call the workers and pay them their wages, beginning with the last ones hired and going on to the first.' The workers who were hired about five in the afternoon came and each received a full day's pay. So, when those came who were hired first, they expected to receive more. But each one of them also received a full day's pay. When they received it, they began to grumble against the landowner and said: 'These who were hired last worked only one hour, and you have made them equal to us who have borne the burden of the work and the heat of the day.' But he answered: 'My friend, I am not being unfair to you. Didn't you agree to work for the usual wage? Take your pay and go. I want to give to the one who was hired last the same as I gave to you. Do I not have the right to do what I want with my own money? Or are you envious because I am generous?' Thus, the last will be first, will be last." Matthew 20: 1-16


