
Lenten Guidelines

- On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent: Everyone age 14 and up abstain from eating meat.
- On Ash Wednesday & Good Friday: Everyone age 18 to 59 are encouraged to fast, unless exempt due to a medical reason. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal that day, and have two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Holy Communion to the Disabled at Mass

Question: Why does one Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion roam around the Church with the Eucharist before going to their station?

Answer: That Minister is bringing Holy Communion to our parishioners who may be disabled or unable to walk up to receive.

Question: How does the Minister know who wants to receive Communion at their seat?

Answer: Anyone who wishes Holy Communion brought to them (or a family member) should raise their hand and get the attention of the roaming Minister as they approach. Also, our Ushers (if informed ahead of time when entering Church) are able to notify that Minister as well - as the Minister passes by.
