- On Ash Wednesday & Good Friday:
 Everyone age 18 to 59 are encouraged to
 fast, unless exempt due to a medical
 reason. When fasting, a person is
 permitted to eat one full meal that day,
 and have two smaller meals that together
 are not equal to a full meal.
