Jesus said to his disciples: "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower. He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Holy Communion to the Disabled at Mass

Question: Why does one Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion roam around the Church with the Eucharist before going to their station?

Answer: That Minister is bringing Holy Communion to our parishioners who may be disabled or unable to walk up to receive.

Question: How does the Minister know who wants to receive Communion at their seat?

Answer: Anyone who wishes Holy Communion brought to them (or a family member) should raise their hand and get the attention of the roaming Minister as they approach. Also, our Ushers (if informed ahead of time when entering Church) are able to notify that Minister as well - as the Minister passes by.
