Together, they have two children, Alejandra (22) and Evan Brandon (20), both born in Orlando, Florida, where their family has experienced a rich tapestry of locations and experiences. They have been active members of Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini Catholic Church since its beginning in November, 2019.



Throughout their six-year journey in the Orlando Diaconate Formation Program, the Rivas family's commitment to 'ministry of service' has deepened. Despite facing challenges such as time commitments and academic demands, they have been blessed with abundant graces that have helped them overcome many obstacles. They have undergone significant spiritual growth, supported by their family and Faith community, while mentors and trainers have equipped them with the skills and spirituality for their journey ahead.

At Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini, John and Leidy lead the 'Fully Engaged' Marriage ministry and manage schedules for Liturgical Ministry Volunteers. Their ministry extends beyond the Parish, including involvement in various roles with Catholic Charities of Central Florida, where Leidy serves as the Director of the Culture of Life office. Looking ahead, the Rivas family is eager to commit themselves to living out the principles of faith through service and community.

John will be ordained a permanent deacon at the Basilica of the National Shrine of Mary, Queen of the Universe, on June 8th at 10 AM. All are welcome to come and witness this sacred event.
