

### For <u>Returning</u> students:

- \* Returning Students to our Sacramental Prep Program (who were already enrolled in 1<sup>st</sup> Grade; 7<sup>th</sup> Grade; or Family Faith Formation 6<sup>th</sup> Grade) will be automatically re-enrolled for First Communion or Confirmation Visions I, or Confirmation Visions II. Parents do not have to register these students again. We will send you an email with more detailed information, and a link to pay the Registration Donation (\$125.00 per student).
- Students entering 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Grades (who have already completed their Sacramental Preparation and recently received a Sacrament);

   or students entering Kindergarten can register them (with their family) in our Family Faith Formation Program. 


