On the first day of the Festival of Unleavened Bread, when it was customary to sacrifice the Passover lamb, Jesus' disciples asked him, "Where do you want us to go and make preparations for you to eat the Passover?" So, he sent two of his disciples, telling them, "Go into the city, and a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him. Say to the owner of the house he enters, 'The Teacher asks: Where is my guest room, where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?' He will show you a large room upstairs, furnished and ready. Make preparations for us there." The disciples left, went into the city and found things just as Jesus had told them. So, they prepared the Passover. While they were eating, Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take it; this is my body." Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, and they all drank from it. "This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many," he said to them. "Truly I tell you, I will not drink again from the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God." When they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives. Online Registration (Enrollment) for our 'Mini' Faith Formation Program opened on May 31, 2024

## For Returning students:

- \* Returning Students to our **Sacramental Prep Program** (who were already enrolled in 1<sup>st</sup> Grade; 7<sup>th</sup> Grade; or Family Faith Formation 6<sup>th</sup> Grade) will be automatically re-enrolled for First Communion or Confirmation Visions I, or Confirmation Visions II. Parents do not have to register these students again. We will send you an email with more detailed information, and a link to pay the Registration Donation (\$125.00 per student).
- \* Students entering 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Grades (who have already completed their Sacramental Preparation and recently received a Sacrament);

   or students entering Kindergarten can register them (with their family) in our **Family Faith Program**. Go to our Parish Website:


