Overhearing what they said, Jesus told him, "Don't be afraid; just believe." He did not let anyone follow him except Peter, James and John the brother of

James. When they came to the home of the synagogue leader, Jesus saw a commotion, with people crying and wailing loudly. He went in and said to them, "Why all this commotion and wailing? The child is not dead but asleep." But they laughed at him. After he put them all out, he took the child's father and mother and the disciples who were with him, and went in where the child was. He took her by the hand and said to her, "Talitha koum!" (which means "Little girl, I say to you, get up!"). Immediately the girl stood up and began to walk around (she was twelve years old). At this they were

completely astonished. He gave strict orders not to let anyone know about this, and told them to give her something to eat. Mark 5: 21-24, 35-43



Holy Communion to the Disabled at Mass

Question: Why does one Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion roam around the Church with the Eucharist before going to their station?

Answer: That Minister is bringing Holy Communion to our parishioners who may be disabled or unable to walk up to receive.

Question: How does the Minister know who wants to receive Communion at their seat?

Answer: Anyone who

wishes Holy Communion brought to them (or a family member) should raise their hand and get the attention of the roaming Minister as they approach. Also, our Ushers (if informed ahead of time when entering Church) are able to notify that Minister as well - as the Minister passes by.

For Returning students:

- * Returning Students to our **Sacramental Prep Program** (who were already enrolled in 1st Grade; 7th Grade; or Family Faith Formation 6th Grade) will be automatically re-enrolled for First Communion or Confirmation Visions I, or Confirmation Visions II. Parents do not have to register these students again. We will send you an email with more detailed information, and a link to pay the Registration Donation (\$125.00 per student).
- * Students entering 3rd to 6th Grades (who have already completed their Sacramental Preparation and recently received a Sacrament);

 or students entering Kindergarten can register them (with their family) in our **Family Faith Program**. Go to our Parish Website:


