SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



Some time after this, Jesus crossed to the far shore of the Sea of Galilee (that is, the Sea of Tiberias), and a great crowd of people followed him because they saw the signs he had performed by healing the sick. Then Jesus went up on a mountainside and sat down with his disciples. The Jewish Passover Festival was near. When Jesus looked up and saw a great crowd coming toward him, he said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread for these people to eat?" He asked this only to test him, for he already had in mind what he was going to do. Philip answered him, "It would take more than half a year's wages to buy enough bread for each one to have a bite!" Another of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, spoke up, "Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?" Jesus said, "Have the people sit down." There was plenty of grass in that place, and they sat down (about five thousand men were there). Jesus then took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish. When they had all had enough to eat, he said to his disciples, "Gather the pieces that are left over. Let nothing be wasted." So, they gathered them and filled twelve baskets with the pieces of the five barley loaves left over by those who had eaten. After the people saw the sign Jesus performed, they began to say, "Surely this is the Prophet who is to come into the world." Jesus, knowing that they intended to come and make him king by force, withdrew again to a mountain by himself.



In 2021, Pope Francis established a 'World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly'. It is celebrated on Sunday, July 28, 2024 - the Sunday closest to the **Feast of Saints Joachim and Anne (7/26)**, Grandparents of Jesus. The theme chosen by Pope Francis for this year's celebration is from Psalm 71:9 - "Do not cast me off in my old age."

To help in assisting to make our Choir/Instrumentalists more visible – and for leading congregation participation in music – this weekend you will notice that they have been relocated to the ground floor (over by the Food Court). You may also notice that the Presider Chair & Altar Servers have switched to the other side of the Tabernacle. Let's see how this works!

Online Registration (Enrollment) for our 'Mini' Faith Formation Program opened on May 31, 2024

For Returning students:

- * Returning Students to our **Sacramental Prep Program** (who were already enrolled in 1st Grade; 7th Grade; or Family Faith Formation 6th Grade) will be automatically re-enrolled for First Communion or Confirmation Visions I, or Confirmation Visions II. Parents do not have to register these students again. We will send you an email with more detailed information, and a link to pay the Registration Donation (\$125.00 per student).
- * Students entering 3rd to 6th Grades (who have already completed their Sacramental Preparation and recently received a Sacrament); – or students entering Kindergarten – can register them (with their family) in our **Family Faith Program**. Go to our Parish Website: www.SaintCabriniCatholic.org; move mouse to 'Faith Formation' tab at top; then scroll down and click on 'Family Faith Program.' Fill out Online Registration Form (one per family) and follow the link to pay the Registration Donation (\$125.00 per family). **Online Registration Opened May 31st, 2024.**

For New students entering our Program(s) for the first time:

- * In addition, print/fill out/sign the 'Image Release Form' (one per student) – English or Spanish. Bring the completed 'Image Release Form' to our next **Church Office Open** date at the school on June 16, 2024 (8:30-10:15 AM).
