

## Our Catholic Appeal

Question: At the end of the 11-month parishioner pledge system, when the O.C.A. Goal of a Parish has been paid – and a Parish goes over their Appeal goal – what happens to any over-goal dollars (overage)?

Answer: There is a 'share formula' in place that disperses any overage that may be accrued at the end of the O.C.A. Appeal time period – after the Parish goal is attained and paid off; 1/3 of overage goes to the Parish; 1/3 goes to the Parish Endowment Fund; and 1/3 is contributed to a Fund to build priest housing at San Pedro and support retired Diocesan priests.
