TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



John said to Jesus, "Teacher, we saw someone driving out demons in your name and we told him to stop, because he was not one of us." Jesus said in reply, "Do not stop him. For no one who does a miracle in my name can in the next moment say anything bad about me. Whoever is not against us is for us. Truly I tell you, anyone who gives you a cup of water in my name because you belong to the Messiah will certainly not lose their reward. If anyone causes one of these little ones - those who believe in me - to stumble, it would be better for them if a large millstone were hung around their neck and they were thrown into the sea. If your hand causes you to stumble, cut it off. It is better for you to enter life maimed than with two hands to go into Gehenna, where the fire never goes out. And if your foot causes you to stumble, cut it off. It is better for you to enter life crippled than to have two feet and be thrown into Gehenna. And if your eye causes you to stumble, pluck it out. It is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye than to have two eyes and be thrown into Gehenna, where 'the worms that eat them do not die, and the fire is not quenched.'" 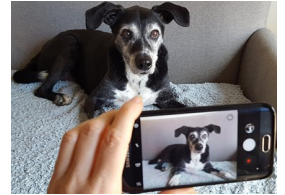
