TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

My Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Hope all is okay with you and your families, and that you fared well with the hurricane. Continue to pray for those who were greatly affected - and for the lives lost. It was a tragic event for many.

I recently heard from Narcoossee Middle School, and we should be on track with this weekend's Masses; Family Faith, and Confirmation III Programs - and with anything else that is scheduled, such as the Sister Diocese presenter.

Last weekend, Deacon Johnny and I were stationed in the main driveway to the Church (up at Narcoossee Road) for all of our Mass times, in case some of our people did not know that the campus was closed because of no power. 400 people came through in their cars to receive Holy Communion and a Blessing. What a ministry moment that was!

Given the recent hurricanes, etc. occurring over the past month or so, the Diocese of Orlando has asked all of its Parishes to participate in a special Second Collection the weekend of October 26/27 - called 'Disaster Relief, 2024.' It is for the humanitarian assistance needs arising from these calamities. The funds collected in this special appeal will be used to support the efforts of the official relief agencies of the U.S. Catholic Church - Catholic Charities USA and/or Catholic Relief Services, as they and their local agencies respond to immediate emergency needs for such necessities as water, food, shelter, medical care, and aid in long-term rebuilding and recovery efforts.
