THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT



Gaudete Sunday

is the third Sunday of Advent in the Christian liturgical calendar and is marked by a shift in focus and a lighter mood. The name comes from the Latin word Gaudete, which means "rejoice." The focus shifts from "The Lord is Coming" to "The Lord is Near." Readings are based on rejoicing in the Lord, the mission of Saint John the Baptist, - and to pray without ceasing; to give thanks; and in not quenching the Spirit. The rose-colored candle is lit on the Advent Wreath. This tradition of Gaudete Sunday dates back to the fourth or fifth century, and is celebrated in the Roman Catholic and Lutheran Churches; the Anglican Community; and other mainline Protestant Churches.



The crowds asked John, "What should we do then?" John answered, "Anyone who has two shirts should share with the one who has none, and anyone who has food should do the same." Even tax collectors came to be baptized. "Teacher," they asked, "what should we do?" "Don't collect any more than you are required to," he told them. Then some soldiers asked him, "And what should we do?" He replied, "Don't extort money and don't accuse people falsely - be content

with your pay." The people were waiting expectantly and were all wondering in their hearts if John might possibly be the Messiah. John answered them all, "I baptize you with water. But one who is more powerful than I will come, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fork is in his hand to clear his threshing floor and to gather the wheat into his barn, but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire." And with many other words John exhorted the people and proclaimed the good news to them. Luke 3: 10-18
