PRESENTATION OF THE LORD



When the time came for the purification rites required by the Law of Moses, Joseph and Mary took him to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord (as it is written in the Law of the Lord, "Every firstborn male is to be consecrated to the Lord"), and to offer a sacrifice in keeping with what is said in the Law of the Lord: "a pair of doves or two young pigeons." Now there was a man in Jerusalem called Simeon, who was righteous and devout. He was waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was on him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not die before he had seen the Lord's Messiah. Moved by the Spirit, he went into the temple courts. When the parents brought in the child Jesus to do for him what the custom of the Law required, Simeon took him in his arms and praised God, saying: "Sovereign Lord, as you have promised, you may now dismiss your servant in peace. For my eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the sight of all nations: a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel." Luke 2:22-32

Jubilee 2025 - Pilgrims of Hope

The concept of "Jubilee" is a biblical concept deeply rooted in Sacred Scripture and Tradition, and has its origins in the Book of Leviticus (25:8-55); and is also referred to in Isaiah (61:1-2), and Luke (4:18-19). These verses underscore themes of freedom, mercy, and redemption – which remain central to the Catholic faith and life. It offers the faithful a time of renewal, forgiveness, and celebration, as it is described as a Special Year of Reconciliation; Pilgrimage; and Coming Home.

Pope Francis has designated the 2025 Holy Year, something which happens every 25 years, as a time to renew ourselves as "Pilgrims of Hope" for a world suffering the impacts of war, the ongoing effects of COVID-19 pandemic, and a climate crisis. Because it marks the 1,700th Anniversary of the First Council of Nicaea, **Jubilee 2025** also celebrates the fundamental Christian truth of the Incarnation, that Jesus is both true God and true man, a teaching always believed in the early Church, but dogmatically defined at the Council to combat the Arian heresy.

The **Jubilee of 2025** officially began on December 24, 2024 (at 7 PM), when Pope Francis presided over the Eucharistic Celebration in St. Peter's Square – and opened the Holy Doors of St. Peter's Basilica – which pilgrims will literally walk through. In addition, the other Holy Doors are located at the Basilica of Saint Mary Major; the Basilica of Saint John Lateran; the Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls; and the Basilica of Saint Mary of Collemaggio – all in Italy. These doors are normally sealed, and only opened during a Jubilee. In addition, Pope Francis also opened a Holy Door at a Roman prison (as a symbol of hope for incarcerated individuals worldwide – marking this as the first time a Holy Door was opened by a pope in a prison setting).

The **Jubilee of 2025** ends on January 6, 2026 (the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord). Symbolically, when a door opens, the obstacles of passage to our Lord are removed. During this time, we hope and pray that the obstacles of personal weakness, temptation, and sin will be removed, so that we will have a holy union with our Lord.

Participating in a Jubilee Year can obtain for a person Jubilee Plenary Indulgences (Catechism of the Catholic Church #'s 1471-1479), by participating in the following spiritual practices: **1)** Making a pilgrimage (and walking through the doors), designated by Pope Francis (mentioned above) and the local Ordinary (Bishop Noonan's designated sites can be found at this link: <https://www.orlandodiocese.org/events/jubilee-year-of-hope/>.) **2)** Participating in Confession. **3)** Receiving the Eucharist. **4)** Praying for the Pope's Intentions. **5)** Being detached from all sin.
