FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT



Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, left the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, where for forty days he was tempted by the devil. Lenten Guidelines

- ◆ On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent: Everyone of age 14 and up abstain from eating meat.
- ◆ On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday: Everyone of age 18 to 59 must fast, unless exempt due to a medical reason. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal that day, and have two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

For your convenience, Sheriff Deputies (if signed up) are on Campus for All Weekend Masses to assist with quick traffic exit and public safety.
