THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT



Now there were some present at that time who told Jesus about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mixed with their sacrifices. Jesus answered, "Do you think that these Galileans were worse sinners than all the other Galileans because they suffered this way? I tell you, no! But unless you repent, you too will all perish. Lenten Guidelines

- ◆ On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent: Everyone of age 14 and up abstain from eating meat.
- ◆ On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday: Everyone of age 18 to 59 must fast, unless exempt due to a medical reason. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal that day, and have two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

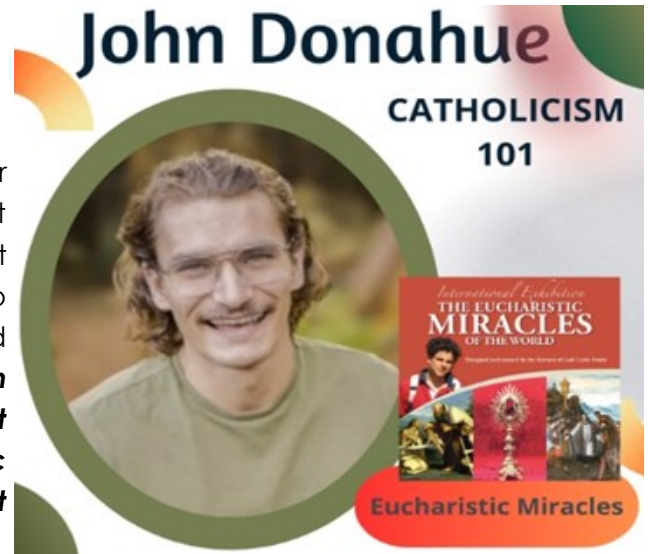
