

Stations of the Light

Pray with Christ through fourteen of the most inspiring events of His post-Resurrection life on Earth



Tuesday, April 24 7:00-8:00 pm Mary, Mother of God Chapel

The Stations of the Light is a spiritual journey with Christ that takes one through fourteen of the most inspiring events of His post-Resurrection life on earth. In the early Church this practice was known as the Via Lucis, or Way of the Resurrection. It invites participants to walk along a path of transforming joy by following in the footsteps of the Risen Christ and his friends. Although known and cherished since the first century, the Stations of the Light were never gathered into a precise devotion until recent years.

While the Stations of the Cross focus on events within one day of Christ's life on earth, the Way of Light begins with the story of the Resurrection and focuses on the awe-inspiring events from the Resurrection to Pentecost. The symbols in both devotions, the cross and the empty tomb, were key symbols in the early Church.

Registration is not required and the event is free, though we suggest a \$10.00 Donation to help us cover the cost of the service.
