



Ordained a priest in the Order of Saint Augustine

## • 1987-1998

Served in Peru as formation director, community prior, professor, and judicial vicar

## • 1999

Elected Provincial Prior of the Augustinian Province of "Mother of Good Counsel" (Chicago)

## • 2001 & 2007

Elected Prior General of the Order of Saint Augustine

## • Dec. 12, 2014

Ordained bishop after being appointed Apostolic Administrator of Chiclayo, Peru

## April 15, 2020

Appointed Apostolic Administrator of Callao, Peru

## • Jan. 30, 2023

Appointed Prefect of the Dicastery for Bishops and President of the Pontifical Commission for Latin America

## Sept. 30, 2023

Created Cardinal by Pope Francis, assigned the Deaconry of Santa Monica

## May 8, 2025

Elected the 267th Pope, taking the name Leo XIV – the first American pope in history
