

Large crowds were traveling with Jesus, and turning to them he said: "If anyone comes to me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters - yes, even their own life - such a person cannot be my disciple. 



'Low Gluten Hosts' Are Available At All Masses!


Cards on Stands (pictured at right) will be available on the Welcome Cart when you come in. If someone needs a 'Low Gluten Host,' please take one Card on Stand, and place it on the wooden Sanctuary floor, next to Minister Check-In Tablet, then take a seat somewhere in the front, middle left section, in front of Podium (Ambo). **This must be done at least 15+ minutes before each Mass begins.** The Sacristan will retrieve any Cards on Stands (by the Tablet) five minutes before Mass (when Choir Prelude begins), and bring it in the Sacristy, where they will place one special, 'Low Gluten Host' for each Card on Stand, in a specially marked pyx, to be consecrated on the tray with the other unconsecrated hosts during Mass. When it is time for Holy Communion, the Gluten Intolerant person comes up in the front, middle left section isle, along with everyone else. When it is their turn to receive, they will step out of the line, and head over to the designated Eucharist Minister (standing/waiting in front of Ambo), who will administer the Consecrated 'Low Gluten Host' to them - then they return to their seat. If no Card on Stand is left on the wooden Sanctuary floor (by the Tablet) **at least 15+ minutes before Mass begins**, no special 'Low Gluten Host' will be Consecrated at that Mass.





Both To Be Canonized By Pope Leo XIV On Sunday, September 7th, 2025



Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, April 6, 1901 – July 4, 1925 (TOSD – Third Order of Saint Dominic) was an Italian Catholic activist, who dedicated his life to social justice issues to better aid the poor and less fortunate living in his hometown of Turin, and was a member of Catholic Action and the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul. He was an avid mountaineer and an able swimmer and athlete. On June 30, 1925, while boating with two friends on the Po River, he began to complain of sharp pains in his back muscles. On July 1, he developed a severe headache and a fever, and died on July 4, 1925, at the age of 24, due to polio. Thousands of mourners lined the streets as his casket passed. His remains were eventually transferred to Turin Cathedral in 1981 and, upon later inspection, were found to be incorrupt. His cause for Canonization commenced in 1932, and Frassati was proclaimed to be Venerable on October 23, 1987, by Pope John Paul II. A single miracle (often a healing that medicine and science cannot explain) was needed for his beatification. The miracle investigated was the cure of Domenico Sellan, in late 1933, who suffered from grave tuberculosis. A priest visited him on December 28, 1933 to bring him a relic and a picture of Frassati for his intercession. Sellan was healed of the disease, and lived for over 30 more years in perfect health. Pope John Paul II Beatified Frassati in Saint Peter's Square on May 20, 1990. Pope Leo XIV announced that Frassati (patron Saint of youth and mountain climbers) would be Canonized in Saint Peter's Square (Rome) on September 7, 2025, more than a century after his death, along with Blessed Carlo Acutis.



Blessed Carlo Acutis, (May 3, 1991 – October 12, 2006) was a British born Italian student celebrated for his devotion to the Eucharist, and of his use of digital media to promote Catholic devotion. Born in London and raised in Milan, he created a website documenting Eucharistic miracles and Marian apparitions. Diagnosed with leukemia, he died at the age of fifteen. Acutis is regarded as a model for young believers, and is scheduled to be Canonized in Saint Peter's Square (Rome) on September 7, 2025, along with Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati. Acutis is often referred to as the 'first millennial Saint' and the 'first gamer Saint' – for his enjoyment of video games. When Acutis was 12 years old, he became a catechist in his parish, Santa Maria Segreta. On October 1, 2006, Acutis developed an inflammation of the throat. A few days later, his pain worsened. On October 8, Acutis was too weak to get out of bed and was brought to a clinic specializing in blood diseases, and was diagnosed with acute promyelocytic leukemia. He was rushed to intensive care, placed on a ventilator, fell into a coma, and was given little chance of recovery. After suffering a cerebral hemorrhage, he was pronounced brain dead on October 11. He died the next day. It was Acutis' final wish to be buried in Assisi. After an extensive investigation of his life, Pope Francis declared him Venerable on July 5, 2018. In 2020, the Catholic Church recognized the curing of a child's pancreatic disease as a miracle attributed to Acutis' intercession. The child was on a liquid diet, and vomited a lot. When he kissed a clothing relic of Acutis, and asked that he should not throw up as much, he felt healed and began eating solid food. Pope Francis confirmed the miracle's authenticity, which led to his Beatification in 2020. On May 23, 2024, Pope Francis recognized a second miracle in 2022, attributed to the intercession of Acutis. It involved a woman who had fallen off her bike and suffered a brain hemorrhage, with doctors giving her a low chance of survival. Her mother prayed through the intercession of Acutis, and visited his tomb. That same day, the woman began to breathe independently again, and was able to walk with all evidence of the hemorrhage having disappeared. On July 1, 2024, Pope Francis approved the Canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis.




