Throughout his life, St. Francis of Assisi encountered the Cross of Christ in profound and transformative ways. These seven "crosses" are not merely physical images or symbols, but moments of deep spiritual trial, surrender, and grace that marked his path to radical discipleship. This retreat draws from *The Major Legend of the Life of St. Francis* by St. Bonaventure, a spiritual classic that offers rich insight into the interior journey of the Poverello.
