Jesus said to the Pharisees: "There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and lived in luxury every day. At his gate was laid a beggar named Lazarus, covered with sores and longing to eat what fell from the rich man's table. Even the dogs came and licked his sores. The time came when the beggar died and the angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried. In Hades, where he was in torment, he looked up and saw Abraham far away, with Lazarus by his side. So, he called to him, 'Father Abraham, have pity on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, because I am in agony in this fire.' Called and Unbound is a contemplative and creative series inviting participants to engage with scripture through imagination and expressive arts. Instead of reading biblical stories only for understanding, participants are guided to enter the story as if for the first time - listening with the heart, noticing emotional responses, and exploring through writing, visual art, and reflection. The program invites participants to deepen their attentiveness to God's presence through sacred story, while also exploring their own personal call and transformation through the gift of imagination.
