






Called and Unbound is a contemplative and creative series inviting participants to engage with scripture through imagination and expressive arts. Instead of reading biblical stories only for understanding, participants are guided to enter the story as if for the first time - listening with the heart, noticing emotional responses, and exploring through writing, visual art, and reflection. The program invites participants to deepen their attentiveness to God's presence through sacred story, while also exploring their own personal call and transformation through the gift of imagination. Together, we will practice writing and art as prayerful ways of engaging with scripture and open ourselves to experiencing scripture as a living encounter with God's Word.

Part 1: Called — Listening for the Voice

1 Samuel 3:1-10

The call of Samuel invites us to listen deeply for God's voice and respond with courage. Participants may imagine themselves as Samuel, Eli, or even the lamp still burning in the night. Through creative expression and reflection, they will explore themes of attentiveness, awakening, and calling.



Throughout his life, St. Francis of Assisi encountered the Cross of Christ in profound and transformative ways. These seven "crosses" are not merely physical images or symbols, but moments of deep spiritual trial, surrender, and grace that marked his path to radical discipleship. This retreat draws from *The Major Legend of the Life of St. Francis* by St. Bonaventure, a spiritual classic that offers rich insight into the interior journey of the Poverello. As Bonaventure reveals, Francis' life was shaped by a series of encounters with the Cross - moments that called him deeper into conversion, into compassion, and into the mystery of Christ's suffering and love.


