Diocesan Property Update!

The Diocese of Orlando has been negotiating (for over a year, now) with a developer to sell the back section of its property. Once these negotiations are concluded (hopefully in the foreseeable future), the entire campus will enter a 'clearing & filling' mode – and a road will be constructed through it (to extend Boggy Creek Road – or whatever they will call it), which will exit the campus on the other end, at Clapp Simms Duda Road. This will become the thoroughfare to bring everyone to a traffic light at the newly widened (still under construction) Narcoossee/Boggy Creek intersection. The completion of the new intersection is crucial because it will allow access to the campus, which will enable us to move forward with a Parish groundbreaking for our new **Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini Life Center**, after the infrastructure is prepared and ready to go. While much is still going on behind the scenes, our continued patience is appreciated as we begin to see a light at the end of the tunnel.
