Diocesan Property Update!

The Diocese of Orlando has been negotiating (for over a year, now) with a developer to sell the back section of its property. Once these negotiations are concluded (hopefully in the foreseeable future), the entire campus will enter a 'clearing & filling' mode – and a road will be constructed through it (to extend Boggy Creek Road – or whatever they will call it), which will exit the campus on the other end, at Clapp Simms Duda Road. This will become the thoroughfare to bring everyone to a traffic light at the newly widened (still under construction) Narcoossee/Boggy Creek intersection. The completion of the new intersection is crucial because it will allow access to the campus, which will enable us to move forward with a Parish groundbreaking for our new Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini Life Center, after the infrastructure is prepared and ready to go. While much is still going on behind the scenes, our continued patience is appreciated as we begin to see a light at the end of the tunnel.


