After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem and asked, "Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him." When King Herod heard this he was disturbed, and all Jerusalem with him. 

Holy Communion to the Disabled at Mass

Question: Why does one Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion roam around the Church with the Eucharist before going to their station?

Answer: That Eucharistic Minister is bringing Holy Communion to our parishioners who may be disabled or unable to walk up to receive.

Question: How does the Eucharistic Minister know who wants to receive Communion at their seat?

Answer: Anyone who wishes Holy Communion brought to them (or a family member) should raise their hand and get the attention of the roaming Eucharistic Minister as they approach. Also, our Ushers (if informed ahead of time when entering Church) are able to notify that Eucharistic Minister as well - as the Eucharistic Minister passes by.
