Our Catholic Appeal

Question: At the end of the 11-month parishioner pledge system, when the O.C.A. Goal of a Parish has been paid – and a Parish goes over their Appeal goal – what happens to any over-goal dollars (overage)?

Answer: There is a 'share formula' in place that disperses any overage that may be accrued at the end of the O.C.A. Appeal time period – after the Parish goal is attained and paid off; **1/3** of overage goes to the Parish; **1/3** goes to the Parish Endowment Fund; and **1/3** is contributed to a Fund to build priest housing at San Pedro and support retired Diocesan priests.



Holy Communion to the Disabled at Mass

Question: Why does one Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion roam around the Church with the Eucharist before going to their station?

Answer: That Eucharistic Minister is bringing Holy Communion to our parishioners who may be disabled or unable to walk up to receive.

Question: How does the Eucharistic Minister know who wants to receive Communion at their seat?

Answer: Anyone who wishes Holy Communion brought to them (or a family member) should raise their hand and get the attention of the roaming Eucharistic Minister as they approach. Also, our Ushers (if informed ahead of time when entering Church) are able to notify that Eucharistic Minister as well - as the Eucharistic Minister passes by.
